Here we are again on the cusp of another Lenten journey with Jesus. Lent is something many United Methodists hear about, but other than the change of colors and symbols, few understand the significance and opportunity Lent brings.

Lent is a season which begins on Ash Wednesday (February 17th) and includes the six Sundays leading up to Easter. Traditionally it is a period of self-denial as we walk with Jesus through His last days before the crucifixion. It is observed with "giving up" trivial things and using those resources which we would have spent on ministry. (It's not enough to give up Ice Cream for Lent, you have to give towards those less fortunate.)

It is a time of self-reflection on our daily walk with Christ as we spend more time in prayer, reading the Scriptures, and reflecting (as well as doing) on our own discipleship, allowing ourselves to be transformed by the disciplines. Oh, and that color purple is about contrition. What are we sorrowful for that we need to make right?

My current plans are to have an Ash Wednesday service time for individuals, families, and family groups as we did for World Communion Sunday. A short time of prayer with the imposition of ashes. (a symbol of our mortality and grief) Reservations would be required. You will also receive a devotional book and a small cross to carry with you.

Now is the time to prepare for this season of preparation. What sacrifice are you willing to make for the One who sacrificed so much for you? How will you offer Christ to others in need? Will you set aside time to remember Jesus' life and teach-

ing? Now's the time to think about your own commitment to discipleship!

February Report of Church Ministry:

Susan Overstreet headed a committee that sent a letter of to each hospital in the area, the Clinton Police Department, the Clinton Fire Department, EMT'S, and The Sheriff's Department including the Detention Center Staff thanking them for their protection of the public at personal risk during this time of the pandemic. In addition, the letter stated that Memorial United Church members are praying for their protection. The church is receiving responses. Thank you, Susan and Committee for a job well done.

The Food Pantry is now serving 99 families with Food Vouchers. In addition the Food Pantry donated a supply of food to the Senior Center at Mariner's Point. Bibles were made available to Food Pantry recipients. Twenty-five people asked for them and three people asked for the church to pray for them.

We have 20 participants in our Max Lucado's study Anxious for Nothing in the Zoom class at 9:30. The participants include members from the Sunday School classes and some from the community. We are impressed with Lucado's writings and his practical suggestions to help us with Anxiety, so appropriate for our times. Finance News

END OF YEAR FINANCIAL REPORT: The 2020 budget giving was \$222,912. (2019 giving was \$235,947). The shortfall for 2020 was \$26,029.00. We also received a Payroll Protection Payment of \$22,700 through the Covid Relief bill. This is a loan which we hope to have completely forgiven. The monetary shortfall after this loan would then be \$3,329.00.

BUDGET PROPOSAL FOR 2021:

All areas except building maintenance and upkeep were reduced. Additionally, our pastor and the staff did not receive salary increases for 2021. The proposed budget is \$261,516, a decrease of \$4,918 over the 2020 budget.

GOOD NEWS: In addition to regular budget giving our congregation gave generously for Outreach, Evangelism, Missions, and the Food Pantry. Memorial UMC's generosity includes: Food buckets last spring - \$4,100; Gifts for the Senior Center -\$2,800; Christmas family - \$3,500; Food pantry - \$9,624. This is over \$20,000! Since this giving does not show up in the budget, we often overlook how much our church contributes to the community and beyond. These gifts are in addition to the Memorial giving.

YOUR CHURCH GIVING IN 2021: We ask that you maintain your level of giving as you are able in 2021. It is a tough year for you and for the church, but we can pull together and become stronger.
