



- Bill Stone has changed 8 of the 9 light bulbs in the Chancel area, making it much brighter and hopefully a little cooler.
- The rear storm door of the Parsonage shattered last week. Bill Stone and Steve Combs are making arrangements for repair/replacement as soon as possible.
- Steve, Bill and Hollis Large are working on placing a new door on the HV/AC building.
 We thank Hollis for making the hinges that will be used

This year's major project is repairing another section, of the alley-side retaining wall.

The Trustee's plan to spend up to \$5000.00 out of our dwindling designated funds account.

A wonderful opportunity has been placed before the Trustees
