


JUNE 2022

Sunday, June 5th, we celebrate the permanent arrival of the Holy Spirit in the lives of Christians. Much has been said, and much could be said about the Advocate, Comforter, Mighty Wind, or Heavenly Dove. Yet, we seem afraid to say much. The Holy Spirit has been neglected in the church for some time and coopted by others for a time as well.

I am by no means an expert on the Paraclete (Greek for the Holy Spirit). I know by Scripture and observation that He works in us and in the world in many diverse ways. He is the giver of diverse Spiritual gifts and moves in boisterous ways in some and quiet ways in others. I have seen Him in quiet contemplative worship and the kind that involves loud guitars and drums.

Jesus told Nicodemus "'You must be born from above.' The wind blows where it chooses, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit."

What I know is this, God the Father sent the Son to live, suffer, die, and rise again for us. Jesus promised that the Spirit would come and dwell within and among us. And if every good gifts comes from the Father, and Jesus attests to the source, why should we fear?

Today, when the Body of Christ is divided and divisive, when our zeal for God's kingdom has waned, and churches are closing, should we not embrace the gifts of the Holy Spirit to unite and strengthen? Should we not open ourselves to the possibility that we should open the cloisters of our hearts and invite in the Holy Spirit to bring real change and rekindle our hearts for God?

We are proud of our Youth for their support and hard work they did on this program and know that the congregation at Memorial UMC are behind us and generous with their Love of Mission Projects.



When children are removed from their homes out of concern for their welfare, they are usually brought to

the Department of Children's Services Offices to await placement with a foster family. This wait can be several hours to nearly a full day. These children often have nothing with them and are scared, lonely, hungry, and in dirty clothing.

Isaiah 117 provides a comforting home where these children instead can be brought to wait – a place that is safe with friendly and loving volunteers who provide clean clothes, smiles, toys, and snuggly blankets. This space allows children to receive the comfort and care they need while DCS staff can do the necessary paperwork and identify a good foster placement.


