

As you are aware this year we restarted a Children's Music Program here at Memorial. Our initial goal was for three children and God blessed us with 7!


Thus far we have spent time working on Musical notation, playing hand chimes, and singing. In the near future we will present these lessons as part of a worship service. This will be the first of many to come.






