# Feed Pantry Informational

#### The Food Pantry needs your help!


We are so thankful for all of the help we have been given (both monetary and volunteer work) over the years. Currently we are nearing the end of our grant money from United Way and will probably only receive around \$4000.00 for next year's grant which should be awarded in the fall.

With the addition of the Blessing Box and the fresh food we distribute once a month, we have invested a lot of money to help feed the hungry in our community. If you take a look at the order sheet we use twice a month it's obvious how much it takes to feed our participants. We have done a sample cost analysis and determined that it costs about \$46 a month, per person to fund the Food Pantry. We currently serve about 30 people per Thursday of each month (or 60 people per month for a total of \$1380.00) On the first Thursday of the month we give fresh food (milk, eggs, bread, lunch meat and potatoes). We usually have enough for the first 24 people in line for a cost of around \$350. per month. The Blessing Box is filled daily (Monday- Thursday) and costs about \$40. per day (\$640.00 per month).

We would encourage you to help in any way possible. If you can't give money, please take a look in your pantry for items that we could use or pick up some extra food when you're at the grocery store.


