From the Pastor's Desk

Lent is almost upon us and honestly, it's somewhat jarring after the joyful seasons of Christmas and Epiphany to suddenly slow down and reflect. During Lent, we stop and remember the last 40 days of Jesus' earthly ministry. We visit His teaching, entry into Jerusalem, and the cross.

Lent begins with a solemn service where we receive the mark of the cross as we begin a season of reflection and discipleship.

Ash Wednesday is like the yellow light of our traffic intersection. The message is, slow down and ponder what it means to follow Jesus. The road seems to end at a cross, although we know better. The ashes remind us of our own mortality as we hear those words, "you are dust, and to dust you must return." Early liturgies of the church used the words (in Latin) memento mori, "remember, we die."

But as Christians, we live in the promise and the hope that the grave is not the end. The season can be an opportunity to allow Jesus' teaching and work to mold us into new creatures. Self-denial is one means, but making real change through good works and giving accomplish more than sacrificing chocolate. While the abstinence can refocus us, if we aren't willing to do the flip side of the Lenten coin, we miss the real opportunity for change.

In the words of Methodism's founder, let us...

"Do all the good you can, By all the means you can, In all the ways you can, In all the places you can, At all the times you can, To all the people you can, As long as ever you can."
